DD#3 Hiawatha-Springton for \$42,206 was approved.

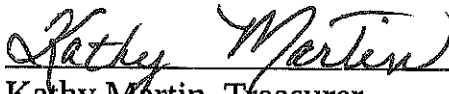

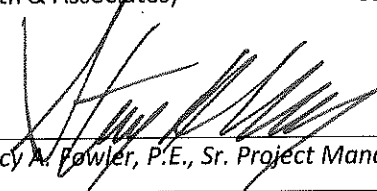
V. PROJECT SCOPE (NOT ALL INCLUSIVE)
